^{*} Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis or, if there be none, the chairperson of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village, or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with the power to approve or veto local laws or ordinances.

Section 1. Purpose

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the provisions of section 485-a of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York to grant a partial exemption from taxation to certain real property located within the Village of Lima, which has been converted to a combination of commercial and residential use.

Section 2. Definitions

For purposes of this Local Law:

- A. "Applicant" means any person obligated to pay real property taxes on the property for which an exemption from real property taxes under this local law is sought.
- B. "Commercial construction work" means the modernization, rehabilitation, expansion or other improvement of the portion of mixed-use property to be used for commercial purposes.
- C. "Commercial purpose or use" means the buying, selling or otherwise providing of goods or services, including hotel services, or other lawful business or commercial activities permitted in mixed-use property.
- D. "Exemption Base" means the increase in the assessed value of real property attributable to the amount invested, exclusive of the cost of ordinary maintenance and repairs, to convert such real property to Mixed-use property, as hereinafter defined.
- E. "Mixed-use property" means property on which will exist, after completion of residential construction work or a combination of residential construction work and commercial construction work, a building or structure used for both residential and commercial use.
- F. "Person" means an individual, corporation, limited liability company, partnership, association, agency, trust, estate, foreign or domestic government or subdivision thereof, or other entity.
- G. "Residential construction work" means the creation, modernization, rehabilitation, expansion or other improvement of dwelling units, other than dwelling units in a hotel, in the portion of mixed-use property to be used for residential purposes.
- H. "Village" means the Village of Lima located within Livingston County.

Section 3. Exemption

- A. Non-residential real property located within the Village upon conversion to Mixed Use Property shall be exempt from taxation and special ad valorem levies as provided hereinafter.
- B. (i) For a period of twelve years from the approval of an application, the increase in assessed value of such property attributable to such conversion, shall be exempt as provided in subsection B(ii) of this section. Such exemption shall be computed with respect to the "exemption base". The exemption base shall be determined for each year in which there is an increase in assessed value so attributable from that of the previous year's assessed value.
 - (ii) The following table shall illustrate the computation of the tax exemptions:

Years of exemption	Percentage of exemption		
1 through 8	100% of exemption base		
9	80% of exemption base		
10	60% of exemption base		
11	40% of exemption base		

- C. No such exemption shall be granted unless:
 - (1) such conversion was commenced subsequent to the effective date of this local law; and
 - (2) the cost of such conversion exceeds the sum of ten thousand dollars.
- D. For purposes of this local law, conversion shall not include ordinary maintenance and repairs. No such exemption shall be granted concurrent with or subsequent to any other real property tax exemption granted to the same improvements to real property, except, where during the period of such previous exemption, payments in lieu of taxes or other payments were made to the local government in an amount that would have been equal to or greater than the amount of real property taxes that would have been paid on such improvements has such property been granted an exemption pursuant to this section. In such case, an exemption shall be granted for a number of years equal to the twelve year exemption granted pursuant to this local law less the number of years the property would have been previously exempt from real property taxes.

Section 4. Application

Such exemption shall be granted only upon application by the owner of such real property on a form prescribed by the State Board of Real Property Tax Services. Such application shall be filed with the Town of Lima assessor on or before the appropriate taxable status date of the Village.

Section 5. Approval of Exemption

If the Town of Lima assessor is satisfied that the applicant is entitled to an exemption pursuant to this local law, he or she shall approve the application and such real property shall thereafter be exempt from taxation and special ad valorem levies as provided herein commencing with the assessment roll prepared after the taxable status date referred to in Section 4 of this local law. The assessed value of any exemption granted pursuant to this local law shall be entered by the Town of Lima assessor on the assessment roll with the taxable property, with the amount of the exemption shown in a separate column.

Section 6. Effective Date

This local law shall take effect upon its filing with the New York State Secretary of State.
