Minimum requirements:

1. High school graduation or equivalency
2. Valid New York State drivers license
3. New York State Department of Health certification as an EMT-Paramedic (Exam #20-267) or Emergency Medical Technician (Exam #20-276)
4. AHA Healthcare Provider CPR

Entry wage: Paramedic: \$21.19/hr and **Emergency Medical Technician:** \$14.18/hr

Residency Requirement: Candidates must have been legal residents of the following jurisdiction(s) for at least four months immediately preceding the date of the written test: Livingston County, or one of the following Counties: Allegany, Genesee, Monroe, Ontario, Steuben, Wyoming, Orleans, Wayne, Cattaraugus, Erie, Niagara, Seneca, Yates, Schuyler, and Chemung.

Application Deadline: Applications are accepted continuously.

Open Competitive Examination

1. An official application form must be filed for each examination.
2. You are responsible for completing **all** sections of the application.
3. Exam title must be recorded on the application, as the application is the examination.
4. The only subject of examination will be evaluation of the candidate's training and experience.
5. Copies of all relevant certifications (EMT, EMT-P, CPR, ACLS etc.) should be submitted with the completed application.
