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Livingston County's Garden of Life Adult Day Health Program Temporarily Closed amid COVID-19 Concerns

Geneseo, NY, March 14, 2020 — Effective immediately, the Garden of Life Adult Day Health Program – held at the Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation on Murray Hill Drive in Mount Morris – is temporarily closed. It will remain closed until Livingston County receives further notice from the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH).

The closure aligns with the following guidance from NYSDOH:

“The New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) is providing this guidance regarding precautions and procedures nursing homes must take to protect and maintain the health and safety of their residents and staff during the ongoing novel coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak.” (DAL NH 20-04 COVID-19 Guidance for Nursing Homes).

“COVID-19 is being increasingly reported in communities across the United States. As such, nursing homes should assume it could already be in their community and move to restrict all visitors and unnecessary HCP from the facility, cancel group activities and communal dining” (CDC-Preparing for COVID-19: Long Term Care Facilities).

Livingston County would like to reassure its residents that mitigating the spread of COVID-19 is paramount to the continued care and safety of the registrants who attend the Adult Day Health Program.
