Number of Positive COVID-19 Cases in Livingston County Remains Unchanged

Geneseo, NY, March 22, 2020 — As of March 22, 2020, the Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting no new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. The total number of positive cases remains at two.

“We need to work together as a community to slow the spread of COVID-19,” said Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director. “This means all of us should practice social distancing and stay home whenever possible.”

County Administrator Ian M. Coyle stated, “As social distancing is now a nationwide effort, we encourage everyone to stay emotionally connected with family, friends, and loved ones through phone calls, texts, and video chats.”
