Number of Positive COVID-19 Cases in Livingston County Remains at Four

Geneseo, NY, March 24, 2020 — As of March 24, 2020, the Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting no new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. The total number of positive cases remains at four.

“To help stop the spread of this disease in our community, the County strongly encourages our residents to stay at home, if at all possible, and only leave the house for essential needs, work, or physical activity with proper social distancing,” said Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director. “As the crisis evolves, we will continue to provide updates and work diligently to protect the health and safety of our residents.”
