No New Positive Cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County

Mount Morris, NY, March 25, 2020 — As of this morning, the Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting no new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. The total number of positive cases remains at five.
