Livingston County Dog Control Awarded Funds for Facility Improvements and Expansion

Mount Morris, NY, March 27, 2020 — Livingston County was recently awarded \$112,500 through the New York State Companion Animal Capital Fund to improve and expand its Dog Control facility, located on Gypsy Lane in Mount Morris. Since the inception of this grant program – administered by the New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets (NYSDAM) – \$15 million has been dedicated to 40 shelter renovation and expansion projects across the state.

“Livingston County will use these critical funds to support the construction of a new intake area for dogs at the Dog Control facility. It will have an enclosed garage attached to a new isolation kennel space and include dog grooming facilities. Old and deteriorating kennels will also be replaced with new ones.” said Mark Grove, P.E., Livingston County Environmental Health Director.

Claudia McAfee, Livingston County Dog Control Officer, stated, “This funding will truly make a difference for our facility.” She continued, “We are always striving to enhance the safety, care, health and well-being of our shelter dogs as they eagerly await their forever home. Livingston County Dog Control is dedicated to the highest quality care for all of our dogs.”
