### **Number of Positive COVID-19 Cases in Livingston County Remains at Seven**

**Geneseo, NY, March 27, 2020** — As of March 27, 2020, the Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting no new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. The total number of positive cases remains at seven.

“The Livingston County Health Department is working around-the-clock to monitor all COVID-19 cases and track the spread of the disease in order to protect the health and safety of our residents,” said Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director. “Social distancing continues to be one of our best defense mechanisms during this time. We continue to urge our community members to stay at home, if at all possible, and only leave the house for essential needs, work, or physical activity.”
