Livingston County Reports Three More Positive Cases of COVID-19

Mount Morris, NY, March 29, 2020 — The Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) reports three new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County as of this morning, which brings the total number of positive cases to thirteen.

According to Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, all three individuals were tested separately at their respective medical providers' offices and are currently at their private residences under mandatory quarantine.

- Male in his 40s who resides in Lima
- Male in his 60s who resides in Mount Morris
- Female in her 60s residing in the same Mount Morris household as male above

In accordance with state and federal medical privacy laws, additional information about these individuals will not be provided. LCDOH was notified of these positive cases this morning.

Rodriguez stated that LCDOH will immediately begin outreach to identify close contacts and potential exposure areas per prescribed New York State regulations.

The updated numbers of positive and negative COVID-19 test results for Livingston County are:

Positive Test results: 13

Negative Test results: 104
