### **Three Additional Positive Cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County**

**Mount Morris, NY, March 31, 2020** — The Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) reports three new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County as of this morning, which brings the total number of positive cases to eighteen.

According to Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, the cases are as follows:

- Female in her 20s who resides in Nunda
- Deceased Caledonia male in his 20s; one household member related to this case is in a private residence under mandatory quarantine
- Female in her 70s residing in Avon; investigation is pending

In accordance with state and federal medical privacy laws, additional information about these individuals will not be provided. LCDOH was notified of these positive cases this morning.

Rodriguez stated that LCDOH will immediately begin outreach to identify close contacts and potential exposure areas per prescribed New York State regulations.

The updated numbers of positive and negative COVID-19 test results for Livingston County are:

Positive Test results: 18

Negative Test results: 121
