Livingston County Reports No New Positive Cases of COVID-19

Mount Morris, NY, April 2, 2020 — As of April 2, 2020, the Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting no new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. The total number of positive cases remains at eighteen.

Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, states, “The Livingston County Health Department continues to work around-the-clock to monitor all COVID-19 cases and track the spread of the disease in order to protect the health and safety of our residents.”

“While there are no new positive cases to report today, we should be aware that the virus is likely spreading without us knowing of its travels. Therefore, it is imperative that each of us does our part to help the community. Please limit your movements to just essential travel and outdoor activities that promote social distancing. Help us stop the spread and flatten the curve,” stated Rodriguez.
