Livingston County Reports Sixth Death Related to COVID-19 and Additional Positive Cases

Mount Morris, NY, May 3, 2020 — The sixth COVID-19-related death in Livingston County occurred on May 2, 2020, according to the Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH).

Livingston County Public Health Director, Jennifer Rodriguez, confirmed that an Avon man in his 70s has passed away. Rodriguez stated, "Our heartfelt thoughts and prayers go out to his family, friends and loved ones during this difficult time." The man was a resident of the Avon Nursing Home.

LCDOH also reports two new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County as of this morning, which brings the total number of positive cases to eighty-two.

According to Rodriguez, these individuals and any associated household members are now in the LCDOH quarantine process.

- Female in her 80s who resides in Avon
- Male under 10 who resides in York

Rodriguez stated that LCDOH will immediately begin outreach to identify close contacts and potential exposure areas per prescribed New York State regulations.

"These cases serve as an important reminder that COVID-19 impacts all ages," said Rodriguez. "We urge residents to continue social distancing and staying home to control the spread of the virus."

Negative Test results: 1,117
