Livingston County Reports Additional Positive Case of COVID-19

Mount Morris, NY, May 11, 2020 — The Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) reports one new positive case of COVID-19 in Livingston County as of this morning, which brings the total number of positive cases to one hundred one (101).

According to Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, the individual is a male in his teens who resides in Avon. He and any associated household members are now in the LCDOH quarantine process.

Rodriguez stated that LCDOH will immediately begin outreach to identify close contacts and potential exposure areas per prescribed New York State regulations.

The updated numbers of positive and negative COVID-19 test results for Livingston County are:

Positive Test results: 101

Negative Test results: 1,528

LCDOH will continue to update these numbers daily on the County's dedicated COVID-19 webpage at <https://www.livingstoncounty.us/1207/COVID-19>.

A recent positive case of COVID-19 is related to the Tom Wahl's restaurant located at 283 East Main Street in Avon. Out of an abundance of caution, the restaurant will be temporarily closed for enhanced cleaning. Additionally, LCDOH will facilitate testing for every employee at this location.

“We applaud the Tom Wahl’s management and employees for taking this proactive step,” stated Livingston County Administrator Ian M. Coyle. “Their vigilance and care for our community’s health and safety amid the COVID-19 crisis is admirable.”
