### **No New Positive Cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County**

**Mount Morris, NY, May 15, 2020** — As of this morning, the Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting no new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. The total number of positive cases remains at one hundred and four (104).

Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, stated, “We are happy to report that recent COVID-19 testing of residents at the Conesus Lake Nursing Home and the Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation resulted in no new positives cases.”

The updated numbers of positive and negative COVID-19 test results for Livingston County are:

Positive Test results: 104

Negative Test results: 2,098
