No New Positive Cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County

Mount Morris, NY, June 1, 2020 — As of this morning, the Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting no new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. The total number of positive cases remains at one hundred and seventeen (117). Of these 117 cases, 104 are recovered and 6 are active.

The updated numbers of positive and negative COVID-19 test results for Livingston County are:

Positive Test results: 117

Negative Test results: 3,795

Ian M.
