### **No Active Cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County**

**Mount Morris, NY, June 26, 2020** — As of this morning, the Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting no active cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. The total number of positive cases remains at one hundred twenty four (124). Of these 124 cases, 116 have recovered and 0 are active.

Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, stated, “Today, we have reached a milestone. This is the first time since the pandemic started that we have no active cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. It is a good day to celebrate the positive trends we continue to see with our metrics.”

“To each and every resident, your vigilance has been a key component in pushing us forward,” Rodriguez continued. “Even though we are meeting our metrics and our economy continues to reopen, we must not let our guard down. Please continue to work together as a community to social distance, wear masks, and frequently wash or sanitize your hands and places of contact so that we can continue to move in a positive direction.”

The updated numbers of positive and negative COVID-19 test results for Livingston County are:

Positive Test results: 124

Negative Test results: 8,002
