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Livingston County Encourages Residents to Remain Vigilant as Number of Active COVID-19 Cases Increases

Mount Morris, NY, July 14, 2020 — The Livingston County Department of Health is reporting four new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County as of this morning, which brings the total number of positive cases to one hundred and forty seven (147). Of these 147 cases, 125 have recovered and 14 are active.

According to Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, the new positive cases and any associated household members are now in the LCDOH quarantine process.

“We are seeing an increase in the number of active cases as of late. This increase, in part, can be attributed to social gatherings and travelers from high risk areas,” stated Rodriguez. “Now is a good time to remind our residents that that COVID-19 is still prevalent all around us and among all ages. Please remain vigilant and keep your guard up. We encourage folks to stay smart and do their part to protect the health of the community.”

County health officials continue to ask residents to take precautions in order to slow the spread of COVID-19. Precautionary measures include wearing face masks, maintaining a 6-foot distance from others in public places, and washing hands regularly.

The updated numbers of positive and negative COVID-19 test results for Livingston County are:

Positive Test results: 147

Negative Test results: 10,715
