Livingston County Reports a Positive Case of COVID-19 at Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation

Mount Morris, NY, July 17, 2020 — The Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) is reporting two new positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County as of this morning, which brings the total number of positive cases to one hundred and fifty three (153). Of these 153 cases, 131 have recovered and 14 are active.

According to Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, the new positive cases and any associated household members are now in the LCDOH quarantine process.

A positive case from July 16, 2020 is a resident at the Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation (CNR). Rodriguez stated, "The Livingston County Department of Health has been working closely with the CNR on infection control practices and quarantine measures."

Stephen Woodruff, Director of the CNR, said, "We have notified all family members and staff per standard protocol. The CNR is taking every precaution to prevent the further spread of COVID-19." The CNR [website](#) contains additional information about the CNR's infection controls and operational strategies to maximize the safety of all individuals at the facility.

Positive Test results: 153

Negative Test results: 11,190
