### **COVID-19 Update from Livingston County: Resident Death Reported at LCCNR**

**Mount Morris, NY, January 6, 2021** — The Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) reports that, as of January 6, 2021, there are 75,892 negative and 2,069 positive cases of COVID-19 in Livingston County. Of these positive cases, 233 are active.

Sadly, one more COVID-19-related resident death has recently been reported at the Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation (CNR), bringing the total number of resident deaths to five.

“Our thoughts and prayers are with the resident’s loved ones at this time,” stated Stephen Woodruff, CNR’s Director of Long-Term Care. “We also mourn the loss of community members who have lost their battle with this virus.”

Livingston County’s Director of Public Health, Jennifer Rodriguez, commented, “As the number of COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations continue to rise, we continue to urge our residents to follow COVID-19 safety protocols – wear masks, wash your hands, continue social distancing, and stay home if you are sick – to help slow the spread of the virus.”

On January 6, 2021, the first of three COVID-19 vaccine clinics for CNR residents and staff was held. The second and third clinics will be on January 27, 2021 and February 17, 2021, respectively.
