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Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation Receives Training Funds

Mount Morris, NY, March 15, 2021 — The Livingston County Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation (LCCNR) was recently selected to receive over \$263,000 in training monies under the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH) Advanced Training Initiative (ATI) program. The program aims to educate staff on early detection of patient decline in order to reduce avoidable hospital admissions.

Eligible facilities under the ATI program are those with direct care staff retention rates above the state median. These facilities have shown an ability to retain quality direct care staff and are willing to make a commitment to further provide their direct care staff with additional training tools to help lower hospitalization rates.

Once training monies are received, LCCNR will partner with LeadingAge NY ProCare, an approved educator, to facilitate the training over a 12-month period.

Stephen Woodruff, LCCNR Director of Long-Term Care, stated, "We are honored to be a recipient facility through the ATI program. Thank you to Leading Age NY ProCare for partnering with us on this training opportunity. It will help us continue to strengthen our staff-patient/resident relationships and the care we provide."
