**Prerequisites:** Firefighter I and SCBA medical clearance

(The nationally recognized Firefighter Level I certification may be substituted for the course prerequisites)

**NOTE:** Each student ***MUST*** bring complete SCBA + 1 spare bottle to class!!

Based on Chief John Salka's "Get Out Alive" program, this program is designed for self-rescue and rescue of trapped firefighters. Course content will enable firefighters to recognize the types of events encountered on the fire ground to contribute to firefighter disorientation and/or entrapment, to have knowledge of what is necessary to ensure their safety and that of their partners or crew members, and perform self-rescue techniques when disoriented, separated, or when needing to exit a structure in an emergency. This course requires students to perform a number of practical evolutions with self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA). This course includes the National Fire Academy Calling the Mayday.
