COVID-19 Update from Livingston County

GENESEO, N.Y., September 23, 2021 — The Livingston County Department of Health (LCDOH) reports that, as of September 22, 2021, the County's current COVID-19 vaccination rate is 57%. In addition, there are 106 active cases, a weekly positivity rate of 4.17%, an ICU bed capacity of 80%, five hospitalizations, and two deaths related to the virus.

Jennifer Rodriguez, Livingston County Public Health Director, confirmed that a male in his 70s from Conesus ZIP code 14435 and a female in her 90s from Conesus ZIP code 14435 recently passed away. Rodriguez stated, "We offer our deepest condolences to their families, friends and loved ones during this difficult time."

Rodriguez continued, "Please be mindful as the cooler weather approaches. This is a transitional time of year when people, in general, are more susceptible to viruses and other infections."
