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Livingston County to Hold Tax Foreclosure Auction

GENESEO, N.Y., September 29, 2021 – Livingston County will hold a foreclosed real property tax auction on Thursday, Oct. 28, 2021, at 6 p.m. at the Livingston County Highway Facility, 4389 Gypsy Lane, Mt. Morris, N.Y., 14510.

The County will offer a total of 28 parcels up for bidding on the auction block. Auction sales will be conducted by Wayland-based Pirrung Auctioneers Inc. All prospective bidders must register at the door and show a valid New York State driver's license or other acceptable identification, said Livingston County Treasurer Amy Davies.

"Interested parties can view these available unpaid tax properties through the [County's GIS Mapping Service](#)," said Davies. "These parcels are all being sold 'as is' and the County makes no claims or guarantees as to the usage, suitability or legal compliance of any parcel."

Organizers require all deposits to be paid in cash or by certified check or equivalent. Personal checks will not be accepted.
