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Livingston County Boosts Recruitment Efforts for Healthcare Positions

GENESEO, N.Y., December 2, 2021 — The Livingston County Center for Nursing & Rehabilitation (LCCNR) is holding a major employment drive to fill multiple vacant positions at the facility. These positions, both entry-level and higher, are available to qualified applicants.

LCCNR is currently offering a unique opportunity for individuals who are looking to become Certified Nursing Assistants (CNAs). The Unlicensed Nursing Assistant (UNA) to CNA Program will provide paid training for employees seeking to quickly advance from a UNA to a CNA. Participants must complete either 40 days or 150 hours of employment at LCCNR to be eligible, said Marianne Miller, LCCNR Recruitment Specialist.
