DANSVILLE TRANSPORTATION ACCESS STUDY PROMOTING INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE DANSVILLE AREA

PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE ANNOUNCEMENT

The Village of Dansville and Town of North Dansville are holding a public open house on **May 29, 2014**, from **5:30-7:00 PM** at the **North Dansville Town Hall** to solicit input on the Dansville Transportation and Industrial and Commercial Access Study. “This will be the second of two public meetings for the study, and we are excited to share the proposed alternatives with the public because we believe they will promote long-term economic development in the Dansville area,” commented Dansville Mayor Peter Vogt.

“Over the past few weeks, our Project Steering Committee has been working with the consultant team to refine the draft alternatives for road, rail, and air transportation investments. We believe these recommendations, if implemented, will help Dansville revitalize, expand, and upgrade its physical infrastructure to retain existing businesses, attract new industry, encourage business expansion, diversify the local economy, and generate or retain long-term private sector jobs and investment. The public meeting will be a good opportunity to see what the public thinks of our work to date,” Town of North Dansville Supervisor Dennis Mahus said.

Participants on the Project Steering Committee include representatives from the Village of Dansville, Town of North Dansville, Town of Sparta, Dansville Economic Development Corporation, Livingston County Industrial Development Agency, Livingston County Planning Department, New York State Department of Transportation, Genesee Transportation Council, Dansville Municipal Airport, Genesee and Wyoming Railroad, LMC Industrial Contractors, and Noyes Memorial Hospital. Barton and Loguidice, P.C. was selected to lead the consultant team for the study. Funding for the project is provided through the Genesee Transportation Council, Village of Dansville, Town of North Dansville, and the Livingston County Industrial Development Agency. The Livingston County Planning Department is serving as the Project Manager.

The focus of the second public meeting will be for the project consultants to present the preliminary recommendations and for the public to ask questions and provide comments on the multiple alternatives for the Dansville transportation system.
