**Course Description:** Introduction to the special characteristics and considerations of Lightweight Wood Construction. Topics include: manufacturing methods, component awareness, fire performance, and strategies & tactics pertaining to fires involving lightweight wood construction. Primary emphasis is on improving fire personnel's ability to recognize the presence of lightweight wood construction and the hazards related to it. Course material enables the student to recognize the dangers, operate safely and better predict the overall reaction of a building during fire conditions. Course includes three (3) student activities. **Designed for Fire Officers and senior firefighting personnel.** Course length: 12 hours

**Prerequisite:** Firefighter I or equivalent.
