**Prerequisites: Firefighter I, or Basic Firefighter, or Firefighting Essentials**

**Course Description:** This is the first course in the Fire Officer series, addressing all of the job performance requirements found in Chapter 4 of NFPA 1021, *Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications*. Topics include assuming the role of company officer, fire department organization, leadership, supervision, communications, building construction, pre-incident planning, and company level training. Additionally, the Fireground Strategy & Tactics for First Arriving Companies course is embedded and covers such topics as scene size-up, engine company operations, truck company operations, and response to non-fire emergencies.

**\*\*PLEASE NOTE: The Fire Officer 1 Course involves a total of 5 modules.** This Course Module = 15 hours.
