Prerequisites: Firefighter I and SCBA medical clearance
(National Firefighter Level I certification may be substituted for Firefighter I)

Based on Chief John Salka's "Get Out Alive" program. Course is designed for self-rescue and rescue of trapped firefighters. Course will enable firefighters to recognize the types of events encountered on the fire ground that contribute to firefighter disorientation and/or entrapment; to assess what is necessary to ensure their safety and that of their partners or crew members; and to use self-rescue techniques when disoriented, separated, or when needing to exit a structure in an emergency. Students will be required to perform a number of practical evolutions with SCBA, including the National Fire Academy *Calling the Mayday*.

NOTE: Each student **MUST** bring complete SCBA + 1 spare bottle to class!!
