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### **Skilled Nursing Facility Visitation**

**The LCCNR no longer require visitors to wear masks during their visits except in the following circumstances: when a resident is on precautions, when a neighborhood is on post exposure guidelines or when directed by the Nursing Administrative staff.**

**Although no longer required, Visitor Covid- 19 testing is always available at the LCCNR and is strongly encouraged.**

- Visiting hours are 6:30am-9:00pm 7 days per week. If visitation needs to occur outside of these hours, please speak with a nursing supervisor.
- All visitors must comply with PPE / Infection Prevention requirements. Visitors who have a positive viral test for COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19, or currently meet the criteria for quarantine should not enter the facility based on CDC Guidance.
- Hand hygiene is to be performed frequently while visiting the CNR. Hand sanitizer is stationed throughout the facility.
- Visitors will be made aware of potential risk of visiting during an outbreak investigation and adhere to core principles of infection prevention.
- Visitors are to limit their interactions with only the resident they are here to visit if visiting on a post exposure Neighborhood or Covid- 19 Neighborhood.
- Visits are restricted to the resident's room or other location designated by the facility when the Neighborhood is on post exposure or on a Covid- 19 Neighborhood.
- There is instructional signage throughout the Center which includes proper visitor education on COVID- 19 signs and symptoms, infection control precautions, and other applicable facility practices (e.g., use of face covering or mask, specified entries, exits and routes to designated areas, hand hygiene).
- Compassionate Care Visits- are allowed at all times.
- All visitors must adhere to the visitation guidelines in place for the safety of our residents. Visitors who fail to adhere will be asked to leave the facility.

**\*\*\*If residents or families are requesting to have a large family gathering in the facility, we**

request that you contact the Activities Department or the Social Work Department at 585-243-7200 in advance, so that a location within the Center can be coordinated. If unable to reach social work or activities personnel, please speak with the Charge RN.
