## NOTARY PUBLIC RENEWALS

New York State Executive Law §131 was amended on June 30, 2023

As a result:

- ◆ A notary public whose commission has not yet expired but is scheduled to expire on or before August 31, 2023 and has their renewal application may submit the renewal application to the County Clerk.
- ◆ All notary public renewals on or after September 1, 2023 will need to be renewed with the [Department of State](#).
- ◆ A notary public whose commission has expired (no grace period) must renew with the [Department of State](#).
- ◆ A notary public who is changing their name and/or address will need to apply to the [Department of State](#).
- ◆ A notary public who does not have a renewal form will need to renew with the Department of State, regardless of when the notary's commission is/was scheduled to expire unless the pre-printed renewal has been returned to the County Clerk's Office by the US Post Office.
