Course Description: Module 4 of the Fire Officer I series. Provides current and potential fire officers with a basic knowledge of how to determine company-level training needs, how to teach from a lesson plan, how to document of training activities, and different methods to conduct company-level training. The course also covers the basic responsibilities of the fire officer as they relate to community relations, company-level building inspections, and community risk reduction.

Based on the requirements found in Chapter 4 of NFPA 1021, Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications. Successful completion of this course and the *Company Training & Community Risk Reduction, Leadership & Supervision, Planning & Emergency Response, and Fireground Strategy & Tactics for First Arriving Companies* modules allows the student to apply for a Fire Officer I certificate.
