### **County Passes Federal Legislative Agenda Multi-Point Plan Identifies Priorities and Projects**

Geneseo, NY... In a unanimous vote, the Livingston County Board of Supervisors passed the County's 2018 Federal Legislative Agenda. The Federal Agenda serves as a strategy to promote economic development and enhance community quality of life in Livingston County. The agenda was hand-delivered to the County's Federal delegation in Washington, DC by County Administrator Ian M. Coyle, who reviewed with each member of the delegation's office the various priorities of Livingston County government.

As the County looks to advance key projects and secure much needed funding, core areas of importance on the agenda include infrastructure, rural broadband, health care, justice/mental health, economic/community development and agriculture.

"Many of the items in the County's strategic plan, including the creation of a Public Market in the county and the study of a multi-generational community center, have a direct connection to our Federal government and possible Federal funding streams," stated Coyle. "We continue to push for funding and advocate for positive policy change from our Federal partners. This agenda creates a platform for the County, with our myriad programs, departments and services, to specifically detail a consolidated list of priorities."

The County is presently in the pre-application or application stage in a variety of Federal funding programs including Brownfields (EPA), Economic Development Administration, USDA-Rural Development and Department of Justice.
