Livingston County's 2019-2020 Strategic Plan Adopted by Board of Supervisors

Geneseo, NY, July 10, 2019 — The Livingston County Board of Supervisors, in a unanimous vote this week, adopted a new 2019-2020 Strategic Plan that lays out goals, objectives, priorities, and specific initiatives for county government over the next 18 months. The strategic planning process included a comprehensive review of all aspects of county government and its connections to the community, economy, and environment.

The plan was developed as a collaborative effort among county and municipal governments with valued advice from residents. Citizen commentary was received through public meetings and the ongoing Conversations with the County town hall series.

“This new strategic plan provides a blueprint for the development and implementation of Livingston County policies, programs, and operations that will enhance our quality of life, strengthen our local economy, and ensure a bright future for all of our residents,” said County Administrator Ian Coyle.

The five overarching goals of the 2019-2020 Strategic Plan are:

- **Economic Prosperity and Growth:** Create a sustainable economy that serves as a catalyst for economic growth and community revitalization and is supported by modernized infrastructure, facilities, and technology systems.

- **Efficient, Effective and Accountable Government:** Strive for fiscal health, employee wellness, and excellence through innovative, accountable, competent and timely customer service.
- **Public Safety and Community Well-Being:** Ensure safe and secure communities through efficient and targeted delivery of services which help protect and strengthen community health.
- **Poverty Reduction and Multi-Generational Opportunity:** Create innovative partnerships and programs that invest in our youth, address our aging population, and help address the consequences of the poverty cycle.
- **Environment and Quality of Life:** Protect historic, cultural, and natural resources and promote tourism through encouraging innovative and supportive community development activities and environmental stewardship.
