Skilled Nursing Facility Visitation

Per NYSDOH Guidance, visitors are required to COVID- 19 test prior to their visit inside the LCCNR and on campus. The LCCNR will assist you in completing a Rapid COVID- 19 in our Atrium.

- Visiting hours are 6:30am-9:00pm 7 days per week. If visitation needs to occur outside of these hours, please speak with a nursing supervisor.
- All visitors must pass the Center's COVID-19 screen prior to entry and comply with PPE / Infection Prevention requirements. Visitors who have a positive viral test for COVID-19, symptoms of COVID-19, or currently meet the criteria for quarantine should not enter the facility, and facilities should screen all visitors for these exclusions.
- Hand hygiene is to be performed frequently while visiting the CNR. Hand sanitizer is stationed throughout the facility.
- Visitors will be made aware of potential risk of visiting during an outbreak investigation and adhere to core principles of infection prevention.
- Indoor visits shall be limited to 2 visitors at a time in a resident's room, unless special accommodations are approved.
- Outside visits may be up to 5 visitors at a time. Facial covering is required.
- Visitors are to limit their interactions with only the resident they are here to visit.
- Visits are restricted to the resident's room or other location designated by the facility.
- If a resident's roommate is not up-to-date on vaccination status or immunocompromised (regardless of vaccination status), visits should not be conducted in the resident's room, if possible.
- Visitors must maintain at least six feet from others in the facility and wear a face mask during the duration of the visit within the facility.
- Visitors may only use the central A1 and A2 elevators.
- There is instructional signage throughout the Center which includes proper visitor education on COVID- 19 signs and symptoms, infection control precautions, and other applicable facility practices (e.g., use of face covering or mask, specified entries, exits and routes to designated areas, hand hygiene).

- Outdoor visits are preferred when resident and/or visitor are not fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
- Compassionate Care Visits- are allowed at all times.
- All visitors must adhere to the visitation guidelines in place for the safety of our residents. Visitors who fail to adhere will be asked to leave the facility.

***If residents or families are requesting to have more than two visitors, visiting at one time, we request that you contact Activities Director, Kim Kavanagh 585-243-7200 ext. 7222 in advance so that a safe distancing visitation location within the Center can be coordinated
